

# Northside

Monday to Friday

You can park in the following locations:

## BEFORE 10am

- Pay & Display (P&D) Bays in Coombe Lane – Lambton Road to Durham Road only.
- P&D Bays in Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) in roads either side of Raynes Park Methodist Church.
- Marked Bays by Post Office in Amity Grove.

## 10am-4pm

There are plenty of parking options...

- All single yellow lines and marked bays, including the Bus Lane on Pepys Road one-way system.
- NOT including 'Residents Only' marked bays in CPZ in roads either side of Methodist Church.

## 4pm-7pm

- P&D Bays in Coombe Lane –Lambton Road to Durham Road only.
- P&D Bays in CPZ in roads either side of Methodist Church.
- Worple Road South Side.
- Marked Bays by Post Office in Amity Grove.
- Durham Road.

## AFTER 7pm

- All single yellow lines.
- All CPZ (from 6.30pm) including 'residents only' bays.

# Southside

Monday to Friday

You can park in the following locations:

## 8.30am -6.30pm

- The four Apostle\* roads nearest Raynes Park Station P&D in CPZ Bays.  
\*(Gore Road, Clifton Park Avenue, Aston Road, Prince George's Avenue)
- On Kingston Road between Carlton Park Avenue & Vernon Road P&D Bays - note that the times on these bays are 8.00am - 6.30pm Monday-Saturday.
- Outside these times, free parking in both P&D & CPZ Bays.

# Weekends

## Saturday

As for Monday-Friday, PLUS you can park:

- All day in CPZ.
- All day on Durham Road
- All day on Worple Road south-side (Lambton Road to Pepys Road)

## Sunday

No restrictions on bays or single yellow lines.

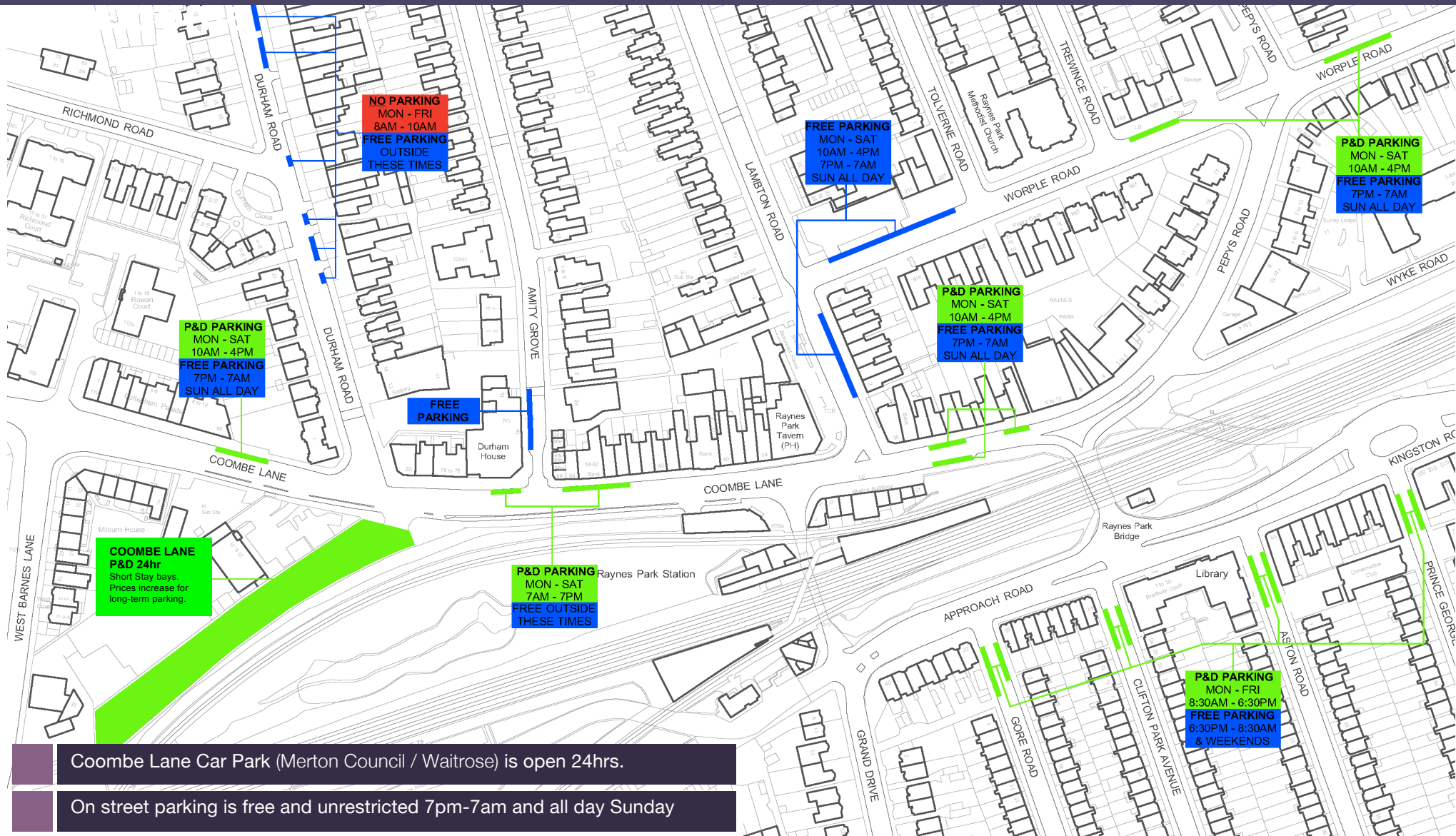

Coombe Lane Car Park (Merton Council / Waitrose) is open 24hrs.

On street parking is free and unrestricted 7pm-7am and all day Sunday
