The Championships 2021 – prioritising access for you during road closures

We recently wrote to you regarding our application for an experimental temporary closure of parts of Church Road and Somerset Road in order to deliver a safe and secure environment for both our local residents and guests during The Championships.

A key element of the planning process has been putting in place a system to ensure smooth passage through the road closure checkpoints for our local residents through the use of vehicle permits.

Please find enclosed your initial allocation of permits, which we ask you to please display on the passenger side of your windscreen near the bottom (towards the dashboard) when approaching the road closure checkpoints. Displaying these permits will provide you with priority access through the checkpoints and minimise any delays to your journey.

We would appreciate you taking the time to send the spare permits to any guests scheduled to visit during the temporary closure, as this will help them arrive and depart with minimal delay. As a reminder, the temporary closure will be in place from 9am-11.30pm daily from Monday 28 June to Sunday 11 July (assuming no play on middle Sunday, the roads will be open as usual).
