To whom this may concern,

I'm writing with regards to Proposal T17 and Policy T6.9. I am objecting to this plan on the following grounds:

You will be damaging part of Mitcham Cricket Green Conservation Area

There will be a significant loss of area of Mitcham Common

There will be a huge increase in noise and pollution to the local residence, especially myself as you plan the road to run alongside my property; you will make it impossible to sit in my garden without suffering from both excessive noise and pollution

Not enjoying my garden could deteriorate my mental health. Being able to enjoy the outdoors in my garden is a happy part of my day. Given I suffer from many ailments that makes it impossible to walk for more than 20 meters at a time, my garden is my opportunity to enjoy the outdoors without causing me pain from having to walk to get to some outdoor space

The pollution will affect my asthma. I moved to this area over 30 years ago to support my health - the trees around my property remove particle matter; trees reduce air pollution

The weight of the vehicles that will be using the access road will impact the foundations of my property. My property and those beside mine are susceptible to subsiding. Ive already had underpinning done over 10 years ago and recently fixed cracks throughout my house. This proposal will only cause damage to my property and those near to mine

There is already a road for access to Willow Lane via Goat Road so this proposal lacks evidence a new access road is needed. Goat road access allows lorry routes to be carefully managed

I want all these points to be taken into consideration for this proposal and policy that i object to.
