Planned Work - CW CPZ Extension

Following the recent consultation on proposals to extend 'CW' Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), which includes Fortescue Road, Clarendon Road, Devonshire Road, a decision has now been made to implement the scheme, which also includes double yellow lines at key locations in Courtney Road, Alphae Close, Christchurch Close and Colwood Road. I am therefore writing to inform you that the works will start shortly, which will be carried out by F M Conway Ltd on behalf of the Council.

Date and Time of Works

It is anticipated that works will start week commencing 5th December 2011 for a period of 4 weeks (but the lining work should take 7 - 10 working days to complete), weather permitting. Work will be carried out between 9am and 4.30pm. While work is being undertaken in your street, we request that you park in Devonshire Road (in the existing CW CPZ) and display the attached yellow card provided on the dashboard of your vehicle. The yellow cards will only be sent to the residents/businesses of the roads to be included in the CPZ. By doing so, this will keep the roads free of parked vehicles allowing a smooth transition of the work. To facilitate these works, temporary restrictions on parking indicated by signs and cones will be put in place. Offending vehicles run the risk of receiving a fine and possible relocation, should they park during the restricted times. Notification will be given 12 - 48hrs prior to work being undertaken in your road.

The information pack on how to apply for your permit will follow shortly. The Council is conscious of the inconvenience and the disruption that this work would cause and will endeavour to keep the impact to a minimum while the works are being carried out. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused by these works.

The purpose of this leaflet is to let you know the outcome of the statutory consultation carried out in June/July 2011, and to inform you of the Council's decision on the proposed 'CW' Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) extension, which includes Fortescue Road, Clarendon Road, Devonshire Road and Christchurch Road (even numbers only) which will entitle the residents of Nos. 40 to 74 to obtain parking permits. The representations received along with officers' recommendations were reported to the Street Management Advisory Committee and the Cabinet Member for Environmental Sustainability and Regeneration on 20 September 2011. After Carefull consideration a decision has been made to proceed with the implementation of the parking controls as advertised and as shown on the plan overleaf (Drg No. Z78-180-01A).

What Happens Next

The final made Traffic Management Orders (TMOs), which allows the restrictions to be implemented and administered, will be published in the London Gazette and the local newspaper shortly. Notices will also be placed on lamp columns in the affected area.

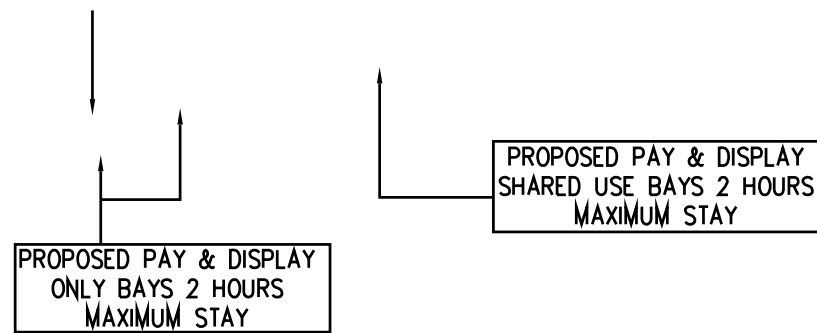
