

Dear Resident

The purpose of this newsletter is to inform you that the Council, following requests for a formal crossing has investigated the possibility of installing a zebra crossing outside Park Community School. However, since the criteria for a zebra crossing cannot be met, the Council is proposing an alternative informal crossing in the form of a speed table supported with a road narrowing and changes to parking restrictions. The details of the proposed measures are shown on the plan overleaf and set out below.

1. The removal of the existing speed cushions outside no. 153 Dorset Road
2. The installation of a speed table
3. The removal of part of the permit holder parking bay
4. The introduction of double yellow lines and the extension of the school keep clear marking

All the above proposed enabling measures require a statutory consultation.

### What happens next

A Notice of the Council's intention to introduce the above measures will be published in a local newspaper (Wimbledon Times), London Gazette and posted on lamp columns in the vicinity. Representations against the proposals described in this Notice must be made in writing by emailing [trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk](mailto:trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk) by no later than 28 February 2020 quoting reference ES/Dorset. Objections must relate only to the elements of the scheme that are subject to this statutory consultation.

All representations along with Officers' comments and recommendations will be presented in a report to the Cabinet Member for Regeneration, Housing and Transport. Please note that responses to any representations received will not be made until a final decision is made by the Cabinet Member. The Council is required to give weight to the nature and content of your representation and not necessarily the quantity. Your reasons are, therefore, important to us.

A copy of the proposed Traffic Management Orders (TMOs), a plan identifying the areas affected by the proposals and the Council's Statement of Reasons can be inspected at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5DX during the Council's normal office hours Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm.
