

## **Lambeth Council - response to Merton's Local Plan January 2018**

Thank you for seeking our views on the first stage of a new Merton Local Plan.

The only comments that we have relate to general cross border transport issues. These are as follows:

- Rail devolution / investment in south London metro – LBL supports
- Parking controls – we are likely to consult on an boundary CPZ in Streatham by 2020.
- Through traffic – capacity reduction expected on A23 corridor as Healthy Streets measures implemented
- Shared mobility services which cross boundaries e.g. Floating car clubs, dockless bike hire – co-ordination
- Local traffic in boundary area, particularly education trips – traffic reduction measures.
- Cross boundary bus services – support for enhanced bus priority.

As you discussed with Catherine before Christmas, we would be interested to hear about the next sub-regional meeting on Gypsies and Travellers.
