As a resident of Wimbledon and in particular Worple Road I wish to respond to your Master Plan for Wimbledon.

Your Masterplan is not considering the current residents of Wimbledon and appears to want to turn Wimbledon into more and more office space with hi rise offices particularly around the Worple Road area which I am oppose to.

You clearly have not considered the current residents who already have to fight to get space to walk along the pavements in Wimbledon. Attracting more and more businesses into the centre of Wimbledon will only make this situation worse.

In Wi9 you say that "The community service has been relocated therefore a net loss of the facility has not resulted" where exactly has then be relocated to -perhaps the same place the Town Hall went to that we were promised following the development of Centre Court - precisely no where. Why don't you adhere to your previous promises first and providing the residents of Wimbledon with a decent community centre before taking the space that was a centre and making it into more offices. For these reasons I strongly object to these plans

In Wi13 you are proposing to take away a supermarket and replace it yet again with more offices. So taking away a community service from residents. I strongly oppose to this plan.

Overall I oppose the proposal to build more and more hi rise offices around the Worple Road and St George's Road area. We do not hi rise office blocks that will end up with this area looking like Croydon, with more and more people blocking up the pavements which already cannot cope with the footfall as cannot Wimbledon Station.

You have not considered whether there really is the need for all this new office space, with more and more people working at home is more office space really needed????

Your Master Plan is turning Wimbledon which was a nice place to live into a business centre and is not considering the residents who live here.
