#### PROPOSED CYCLE TRACK AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN BISHOPSFORD ROAD AND LONDON ROAD PROPOSED RAISED TABLE AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN RIVERSIDE DRIVE

### THE MERTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. \*) ORDER 202\*

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton under the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, propose to make the above-mentioned Order.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to further amend the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 so that waiting by vehicles (including for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this notice.
- 3. NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the Council, using powers under section 65 of the Highways Act 1980 propose to convert carriageway and footway in the lengths of Bishopsford Road and London Road specified in the Schedule to this notice to with-flow cycle tracks, stepped at a height of between 50mm and 75mm but flush with the carriageway at crossovers and junctions.
- 4. NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the Council, under section 90A-F of the Highways Act 1980, propose to introduce a raised table in Riverside Drive. The raised table would be flush with the footways on either side and extend from the eastern kerb-line of London Road eastward for a distance of 7.5 metres with a 1:20 gradient on either side of the table.
- 5. A copy of the proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, including a plan which indicates the lengths of road to which the Order relates and details of the raised table and cycle track can be inspected during the Council's normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden. - 6. The Council of the London Borough of Merton, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on \* 202\* may be cited as the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. \*) Order 202\*.
- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order:the provisions of Schedule 1 and 2 of the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977(c) are hereby revoked in so far as its provisions relate to any length of road specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977(c) shall have effect as though:-
  - (a) for item numbered 166 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
  - (b) there were added to Schedule 1 to that Order the item numbered \* and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
  - (c) for items numbered 44 and 575 in Schedule 2 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order;
  - (d) there were added to Schedule 2 to that Order the item numbered \* and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.


