Dear Sirs,

I would like to object to the proposals for higher tower blocks in the centre of Wimbledon. As a long term resident I do not want to see Wimbledon turned into a metropolitan centre such as Croydon. Wimbledon does not have the road complex to support such buildings. They would result in additional traffic congestion and air pollution. I have developed asthma in the last 10 years as a result of the existing air pollution.

Also there does not seem to be any thought as to what will be needed in the future. Will more people be working more flexibly and for shorter hours with increased leisure time?

In any development of the station I would like to see provision for subsidised community facilities that could be used by community organisations at the rail hub where people can make use of the good transport links.

I would also like to see a covered market facility in any development of the station complex. I will not buy from roadside stalls where food will have been polluted by passing traffic.
