We consider that it is very important to recognise that Wimbledon is primarily a residential area that people visit rather than a business centre.

We agree with the London mayor's position of Wimbledon being a Major Centre and not a Metropolitan as your plan proposes.

It is important to get the right balance.

A real problem with any development of the Town Centre is the fact that road access is limited and even current usage leads to considerable traffic congestion.

High rise buildings are not appropriate. Nothing should be higher than a current building in the centre.

Building materials should be compatible with the current best old and new buildings.
