I feel slightly jealous when I look at the progress made in Colliers wood and tooting with numerous bars, restaurants etc. yet I had the opportunity to live there and did not because of the underlying great things about morden including its transport links, green spaces, lack of heavy congestion. Living in Morden feels like the place you move to because you can't afford to be in those other locations, and that shouldn't be the case - it has its own merit and its up to all of us to make sure that happens. I would like to have a town centre where people can meet and socialise in the evenings and weekends, a decent coffee shop, open later into the night and a few bars and restaurants rather than having to go to tooting, Wimbledon, Brixton. It feels like Colliers wood, Mitcham and Sutton are all progressing in their respective regeneration plans and we are stuck. Now before we get into this whole debate about retailers not wanting to move in until there is sufficient footfall, I'm sure that there are things that the council can do to encourage businesses into the area. The old HSBC bank that is now a community arts space is way under utilised - there are loads of things that can be done here, dance classes during the week, open mic night venues, farmers markets in the weekend etc. I for one and more than happy to get involve and help, as I want this to place we proud to live in.
