PROPOSED CONVERSION OF PARKING PLACE TO WAITING RESTRICTION IN RIDGWAY PLACE

THE MERTON (PARKING PLACES) (W1) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 202*

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton under the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, propose to make the above mentioned Order.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to convert the existing parking place in Ridgway Place, the north-east side, outside No. 18 Ridgway Place to single yellow line waiting restriction operating Mondays to Saturdays between 8.30am and 6.30pm to facilitate a proposed vehicle crossover.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Merton (Parking Places) (W1) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2012(d) shall have effect as though paragraph (i)(a) in column 2 of the item numbered 10 in Schedule 2 to that Order were omitted.

Parking Places Amendment


The proposals are to remove a designated parking place to facilitate the use of a crossover at re-development in Ridgway Place.
