# CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE 5F CHANGES TO PARKING LAYOUT IN SANDRINGHAM AVENUE AND CONVERSION OF PARKING PLACE FROM PAY AND DISPLAY TO SHARED USE

#### THE MERTON (PARKING PLACES) (W5 AND 5F) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER 2020

- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Merton, on 16 November 2020, made the above-mentioned Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to amend the Merton (Parking Places) (W5 and 5F) Order 2018 so as to:
  - (a) convert the parking bays in Sandringham Avenue, the south-west side, flanking No. 353 Kingston Road, from pay and display parking only to shared use parking and allow permit holder parking during controlled parking zone hours;
  - (b) relocate the parking places specified in paragraph (a) above from partially on the footway to fully on the carriageway;
  - (c) in Sandringham Avenue, the north-east side, remove the two parking bays nearest Kingston Road; and
  - (d) relocate the remaining two parking bays flanking No. 351 Kingston Road from the carriageway to partially on the footway.
- 3. A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 30 November 2020, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, including a plan which indicates the road or lengths of road to which the Order relates can be inspected during the Council's normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made at: Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden or on-line at <a href="https://www.merton.gov.uk/streets-parking-transport/traffic-management/consultations">https://www.merton.gov.uk/streets-parking-transport/traffic-management/consultations</a>.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof, or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

#### TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Merton (Parking Places) (W5 and 5F) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2020

Made: 18 November 2020

Coming into force: 30 November 2020

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON, having consulted with the Commissioner for the Metropolitan Police, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers so enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The Order shall come into force on 30 November 2020 and may be cited as the Merton (Parking Places) (W5 and 5F) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2020.
- 2. The interpretation Act 1978(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Merton (Parking Places) (W5 and 5F) Traffic Order 2018(d) shall have effect as though:-
  - (a) there were substituted for the item numbered 3 in Part 1 of Schedule 3 to that Order, the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order;
  - (b) there were omitted the item numbered 2 in Part 2 of Schedule 4 to that Order;
  - (c) there were added to Part 1 of Schedule 3 to that Order the item numbered 4 and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
