## STATEMENT OF REASONS

The aim of the extension of operational times of controlled parking zone 'H1' is to minimise disruption to residents and to limit the environmental impact of traffic entering the Kohat Road area when events take place at the new AFC Wimbledon Football Stadium in Plough Lane.

The extended operational times of controlled parking zone would give longer priority access to parking space to residents. It is a way of controlling the parking whilst improving and maintaining safety for all road users.

The measures also include 'at any time' restrictions at certain junctions where parking impedes the flow of traffic. The proposed measures will improve access, sightlines and safety for all road users particularly for pedestrians and other vulnerable road users.
