ADOPTION STATEMENT

**The Future Wimbledon Supplementary Planning Document
(SPD)**

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that on 18th November 2020 Merton Council adopted the Future Wimbledon (SPD). The SPD supports and gives further guidance of the long-term vision for Wimbledon town centre and supports the implementation of Merton's Local Plan policies.

Covid-19 and the requirements to make the documents available

Under regulation 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 the Local Planning Authority must make both this Adoption Statement, statement of consultation and the final SPD "available" within our Civic Centre, the website and in our reference libraries (Wimbledon, Morden, Raynes Park and Mitcham).

However, due to the current guidance intended to combat the spread of coronavirus this is not currently appropriate or possible. The recently amended national Planning Policy Guidance is clear that in such circumstances the Local Planning Authority must make "temporary amendments." Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt of the named planning guidance may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and, in any event, no later than 6 weeks after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
