I am a resident of Raynes Park residing in one of the Apostles' roads.

I would like to submit my objection to the proposed Rainbow Estate development:

Traffic: Kingston/Busy Road are already very very busy roads and the proposed development would have a major impact on this traffic and parking.

Travel: Significant increase in traffic on South West Trains - have they been consulted in this? As I assume that they would be unable to provide extra travel.

This is a very family friendly, peaceful and quiet neighborhood and an industrial estate would damage this. Not to mention the huge impact that large trucks and delivery vehicles will have to the air, roads and traffic in the area.
