

PROPOSED PROVISION OF CYCLE HIRE PARKING PLACES IN VARIOUS ROADS

THE MERTON (PARKING PLACES) (CYCLE HIRE) (NO. *) ORDER 202*
THE MERTON (PARKING PLACES) (WIMBLEDON VILLAGE) (AMENDMENT NO. *)
ORDER 202*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under the powers conferred by 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the 'Cycle Hire Parking Places' Order would be to designate a parking place on the carriageway in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice for the leaving of electric assisted pedal cycles being used in a public hire scheme operated under an agreement with the Council.
3. The general effect of the other 'Parking Places' Orders would be to remove existing lengths of parking place in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice to accommodate the introduction of cycle hire parking places.
4. A copy of the proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including plans which indicate the roads or lengths of road to which the Orders relate, can be inspected Monday to Friday during normal office hours at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden. 1.	BELVEDERE AVENUE, SW19; the north-east side, from a point opposite a point 6.2 metres south-east of the north-western flank wall of No. 31 Belvedere Grove, south-eastward for a distance of 5.5 metres.	VOn
2.	CLIFTON ROAD, SW19; the north-east side, from a point 1 metre north-west of the north-western flank wall of Nos. 13 to 18 Nutborn House, Clifton Road, north-westward for a distance of 5 metres.	VOs
3.	LAURISTON ROAD, SW19; the north-east side, from a point 11 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Southside Common, south-eastward for a distance of 5 metres.	VOs
4.	ST MARY'S ROAD, SW19; the south-west side, from a point 2.4 metres north-west of the south-eastern flank wall of No. 29 St Mary's Road, south-eastward for a distance of 4.8 metres.	VOn
5.	THE GRANGE, SW19; the south-west side, from a point 3 metres south-east of the north-western flank wall of No. 3 Southside Common, south-eastward for a distance of 5.1 metres.	VOs
