## WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS IN KINGSTON ROAD AND ADJACENT ROADS

# THE MERTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. \*) ORDER 202\* THE MERTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (A1) (NO. \*) ORDER 202\*

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the "Waiting and Loading" Orders would be to:-
  - (a) further amend the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 so that:-
    - (i) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for 40 minutes) would be prohibited at any time in the roads or lengths of road described in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
    - (ii) waiting by vehicles, including for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle would be prohibited at any time in the roads or lengths of road described in Schedule 2 to this Notice;
    - (iii) amendments would be made to better reflect the road layout in Dorien Road;
  - (b) revoke the London Borough of Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (A1) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2014 and re-introduce its provisions so as to better reflect the layout of waiting restrictions in roads in the A1 controlled parking zone.
- 3. A copy of each of the proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including a plan which indicates the roads or lengths of road to which the Orders relate, can be inspected Mondays to Fridays during normal office hours at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden. APPROACH ROAD, SW20; the north side, between its junction with Raynes Park Bridge and its junction with Kingston Road.

KINGSTON ROAD;

- (a) the north side, between its junction with junction with Approach Road and its junction with Lower Downs Road:
- (b) the south side, between its junction with junction with Approach Road and its junction with Lower Downs Road, those lengths of street which are no parking place.

At the junction of APPROACH ROAD, SW20; with Aston Road and with Prince Georges Avenue At the junction of KINGSTON ROAD with Aston Road, Prince Georges Avenue, Carlton Park Avenue, Vernon Road, Edna Road, Dorien Road, Dupont Road, Sydney Road, Chestnut Road and Bronson Road.
