### PROPOSED NO STOPPING RESTRICTIONS IN CHURCH ROAD, SW19

#### **THE MERTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. \*) ORDER 202\***

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the "Waiting and Loading" Order would be to amend the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 so that a 24 hour clearway would be created in the road or length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice and vehicles would be prohibited from stopping or remaining at rest at any time in that road or length of road.
3. A copy of the proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, including a plan which indicates the road or length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected Monday to Friday during normal office hours at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey and at the Wimbledon Library, 35 Wimbledon Hill Road, Wimbledon SW19 7NB.
