THE MERTON (PARKLET) (VC) (HIGH STREET WIMBLEDON) ORDER 202* THE MERTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (WIMBLEDON VILLAGE) (NO. 2) (AMENDMENT NO.) ORDER 202*

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The general effect of the Orders would be to re-introduce a parklet outside No. 48 High Street, Wimbledon and replace the two "Pay and Display" bays at this location with no waiting 'at any time' restrictions whilst the parklet is in place
- 3. A copy of each of the proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including a plan which indicates the road or length of road to which the Orders relate, can be inspected Mondays to Fridays during normal office hours at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden and at the Wimbledon Library, 35 Wimbledon Hill Road, Wimbledon SW19 7NB.
- 4.
