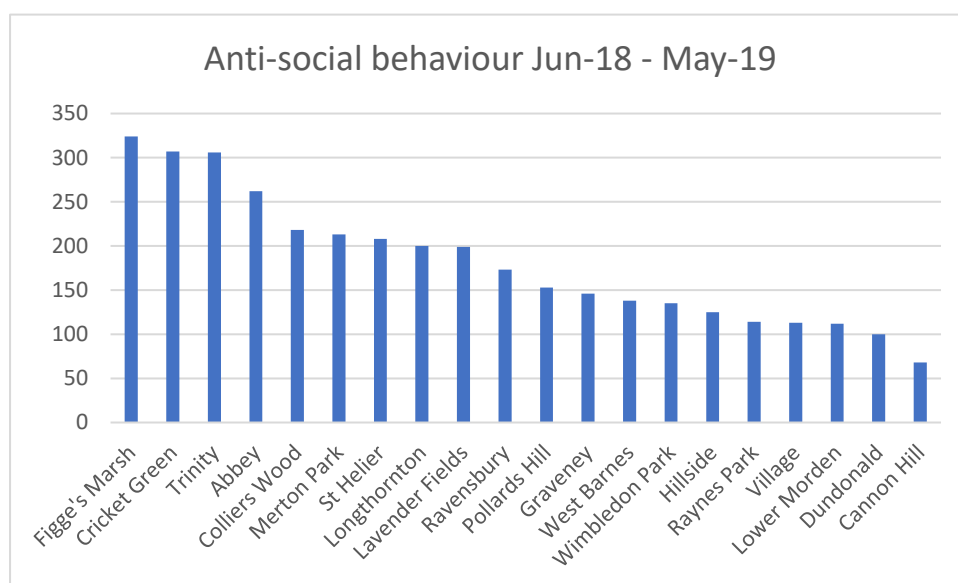


Licencing Research Data 2019 – 2021

This data relates to the ward boundaries prior to the ward boundary changes of 2022.

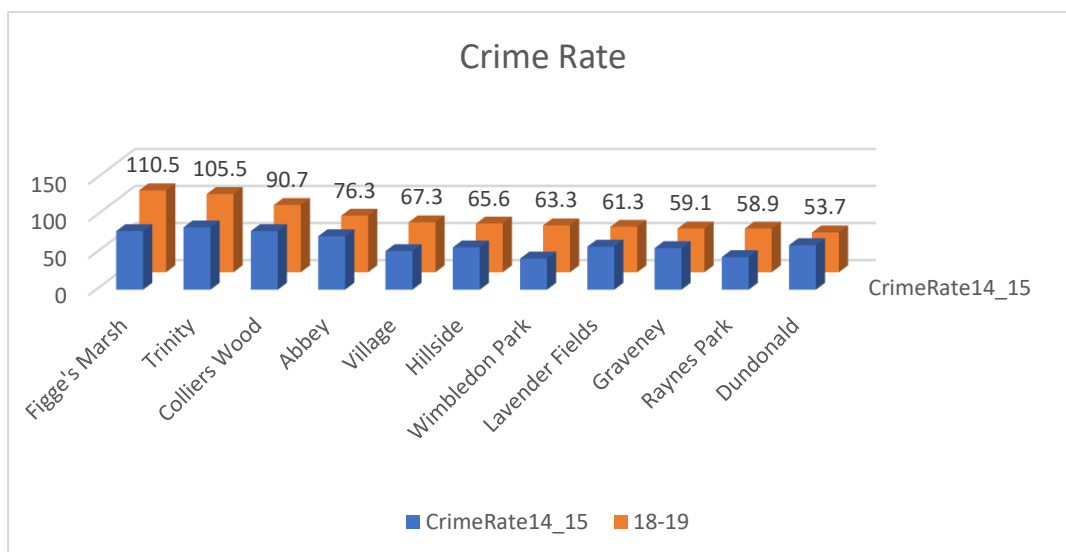
ASB (antisocial behaviour) complaints reported to the council



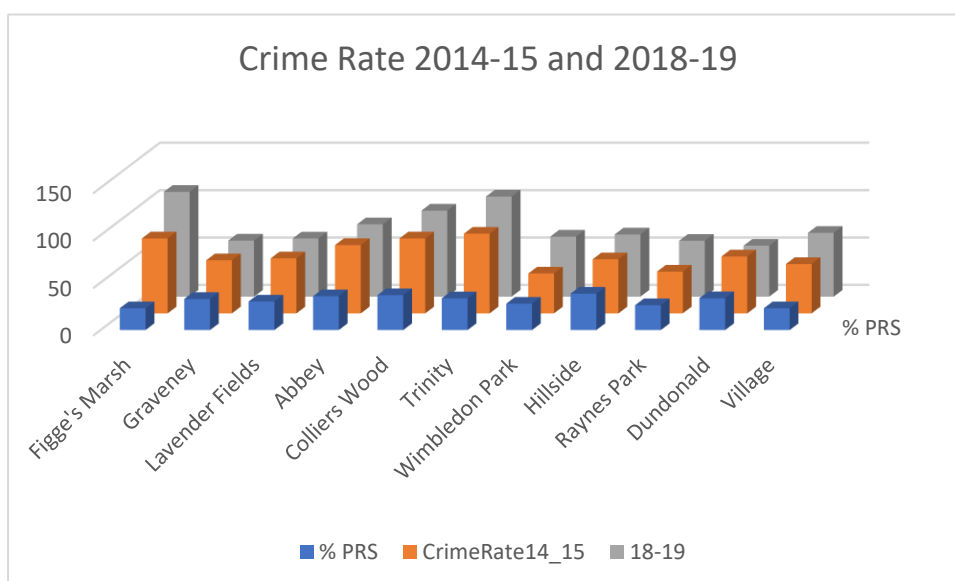
Antisocial behaviour complaints made to Merton Council in June 2018 to May 2019.

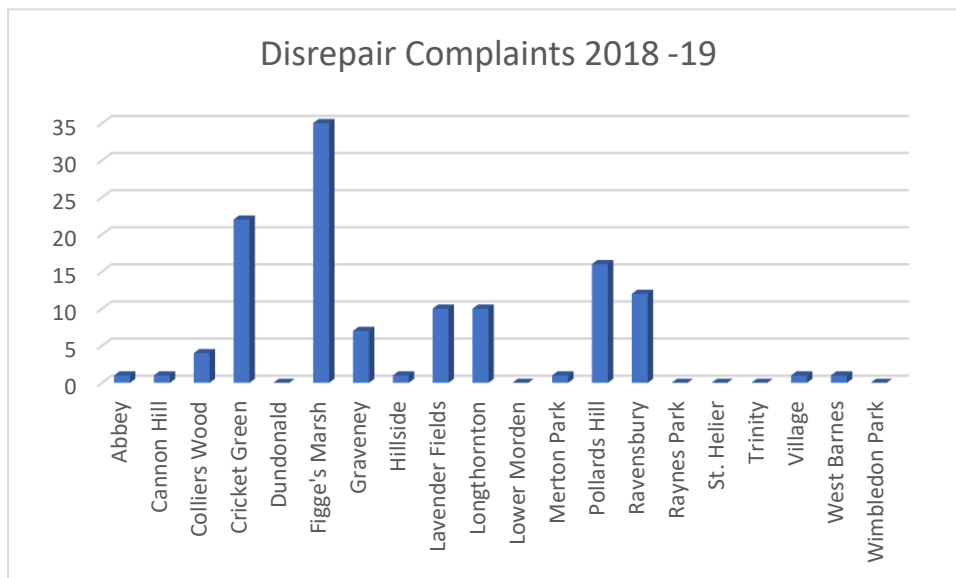
Crime rate by ward (11 wards) in the years 2018 to 2019 in comparison to crime rates by ward in 2014-2015.



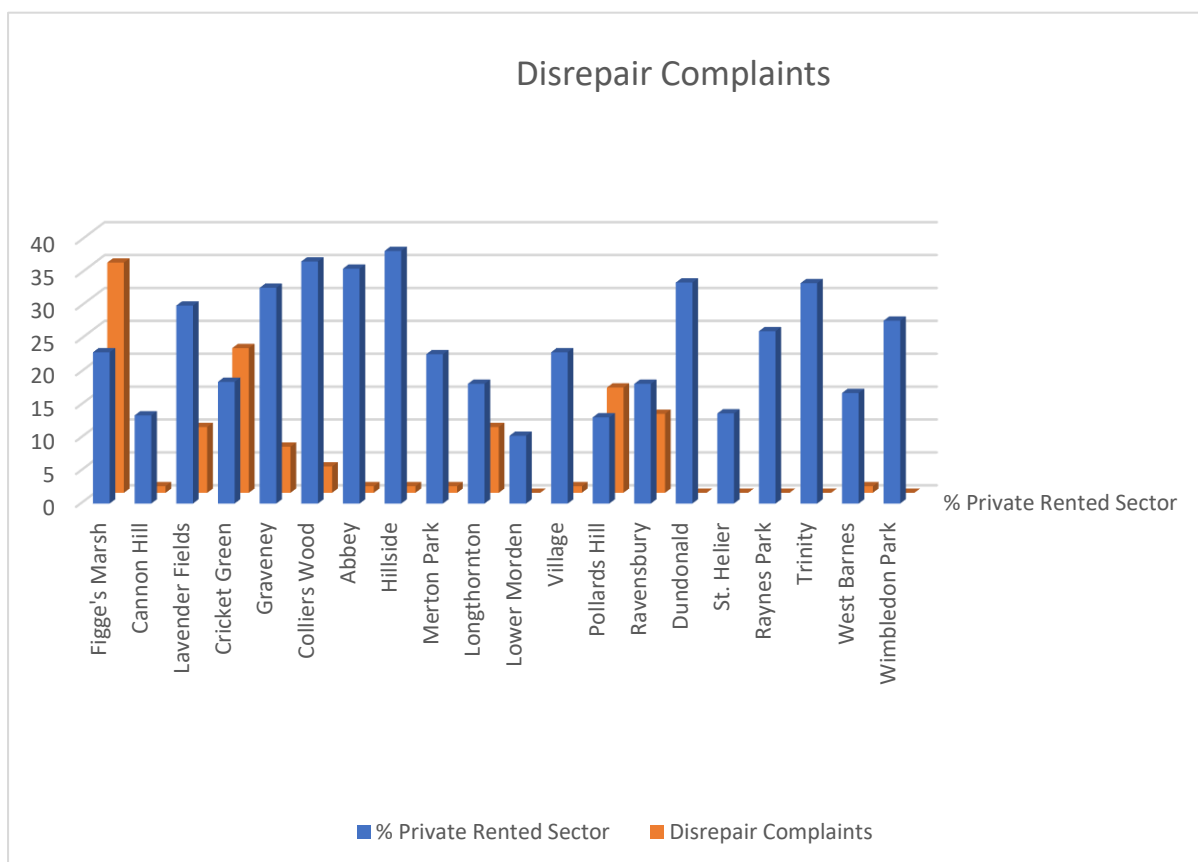
Crime rates by ward for 2018 to 2019 and the percentage of private rented properties (11 wards) compared with 2014 to 2015.

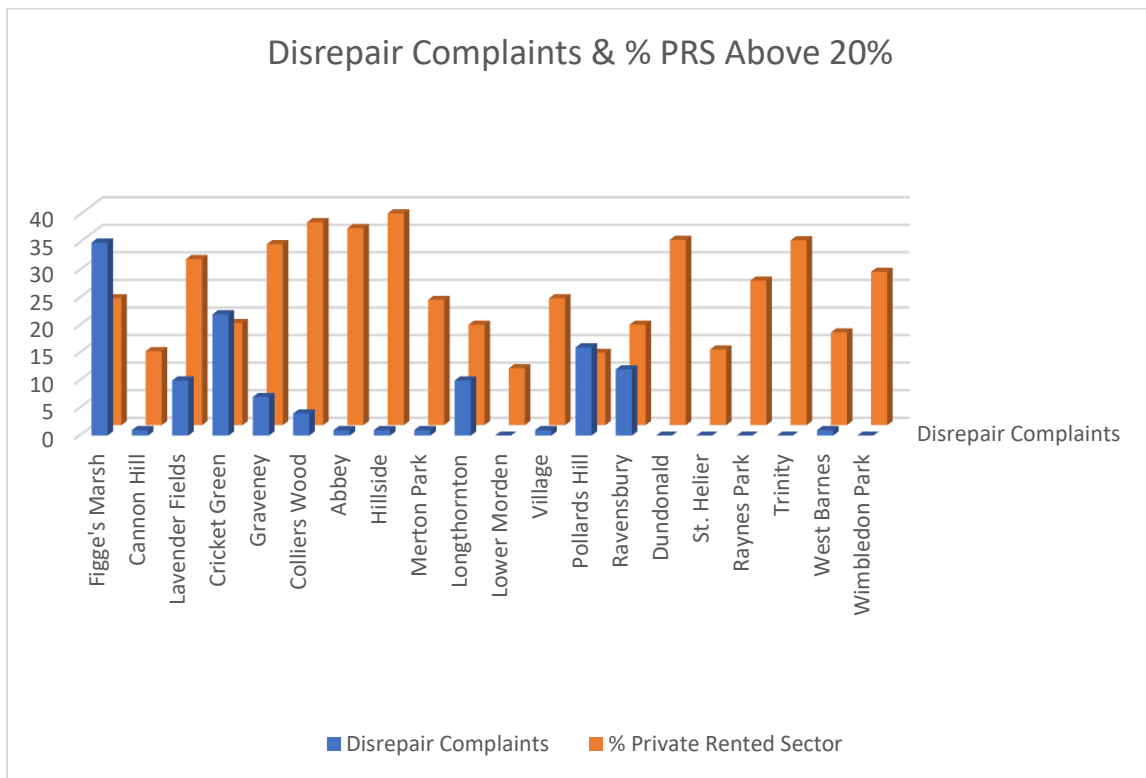

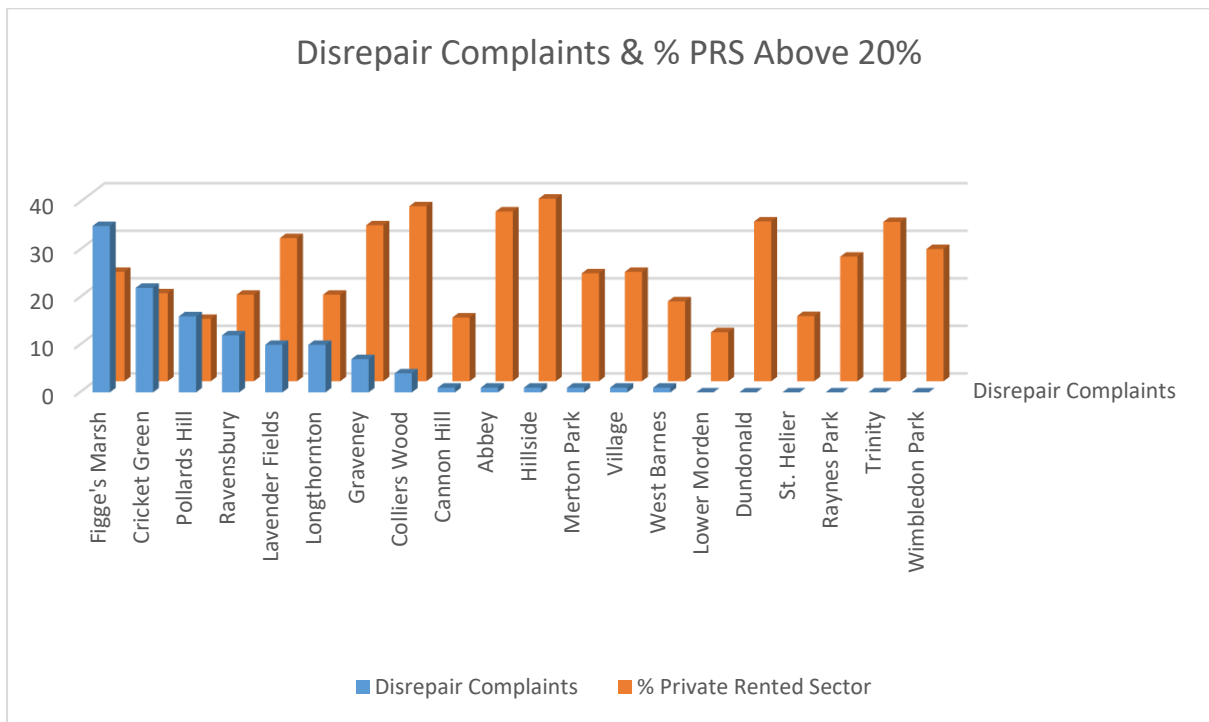
Disrepair complaints made to Merton Council in 2018 to 2019 by ward.



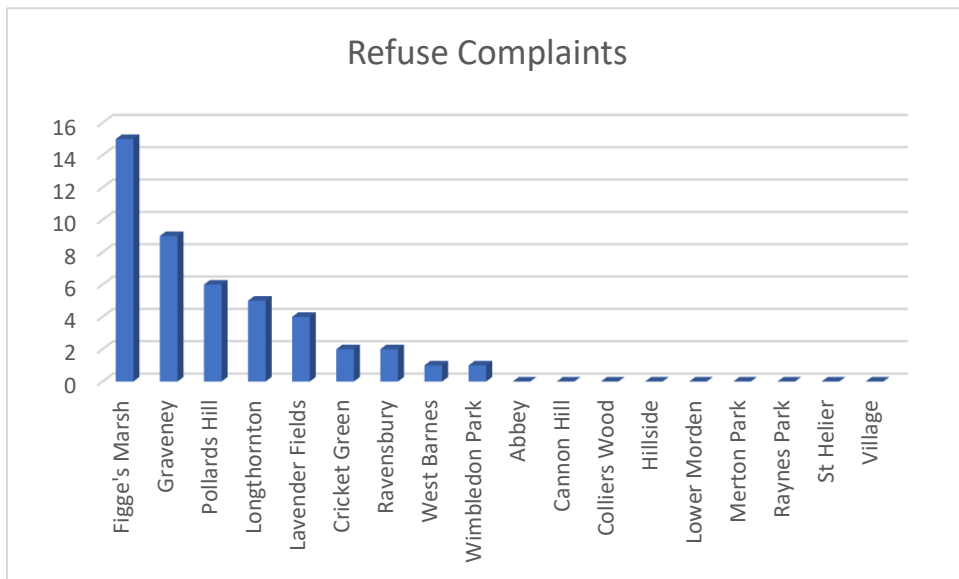
Disrepair complaints in private rented properties reported to the council in 2018 to 2019.



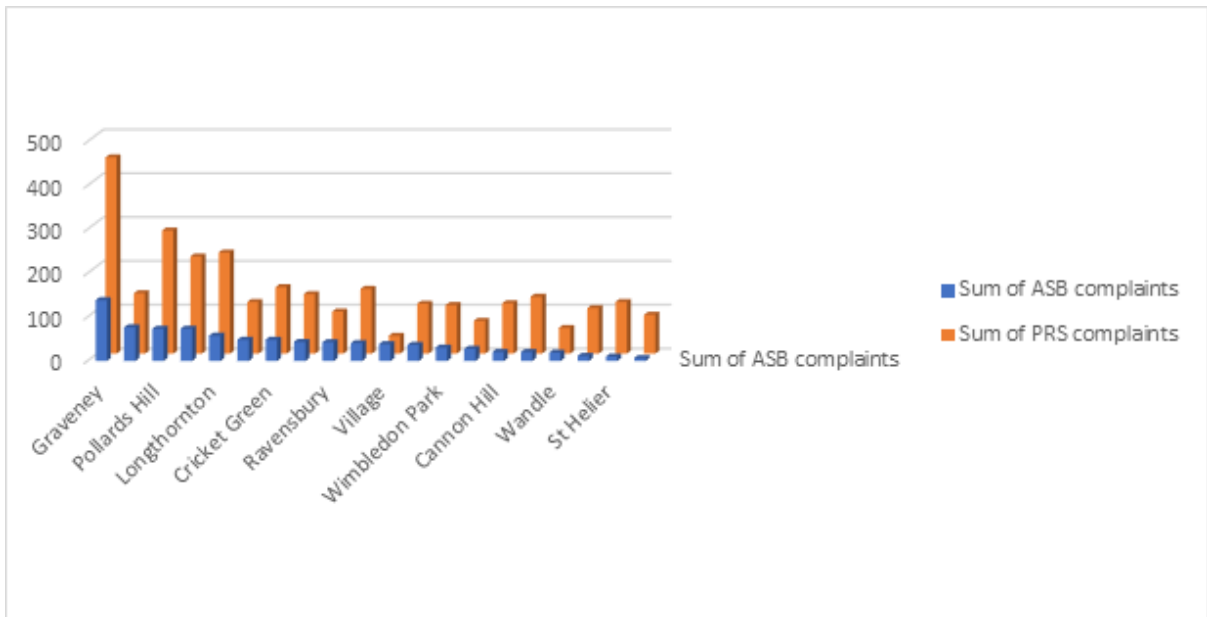
Disrepair complaints reported to Merton Council and the percentage of private rented properties by ward. This shows the wards with a greater than 20% of private rented dwellings.



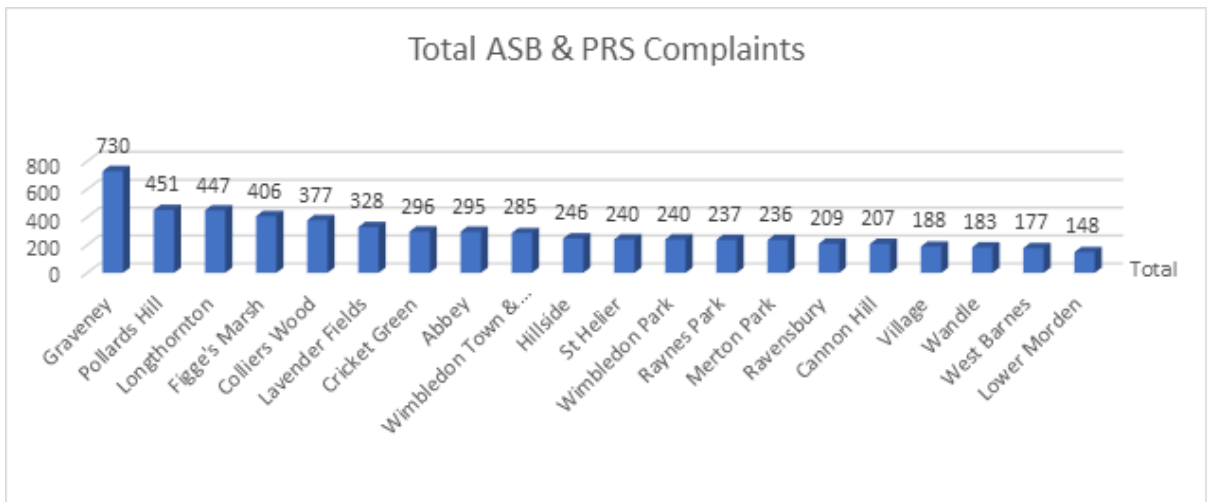

The table presents the results of an analysis of a range of indicators in 2019 by ward (pre-2022 ward changes). The indices included:

Percentage private rented sector estimated by the Greater London Authority, index of multiple deprivation, antisocial behaviour, disrepair, migration, refuse complaints, employment and economic activity, unemployment and crime.

The higher the score the greater the indication for the need for responses to deal with issues relevant to selective licensing.
