



Annual CIL Rate Summary 2022

Charging Authority – London Borough of Merton

Legal note: This statement comprises the Annual CIL Rate Summary for calendar year 2022 for the charging authority London Borough of Merton, in accordance with Regulation 121C of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended). As at the date of this statement Merton is the charging authority with respect of one [charging schedule](#), which took effect on 1 April 2014. The rates for specific development (as described) taken from the charging schedule are set out in the table below, along with the **rates that have been adjusted due to inflation that will be applied to all planning permissions granted in 2022**.
