### **INTRODUCTION OF ADDITIONAL “NO WAITING AT ANY TIME” RESTRICTIONS IN BEWLEY STREET**

#### **THE MERTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 500) ORDER 2021**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton, on 7 December 2021, made the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to further amend the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 so that waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for up to 40 minutes) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of street specified in the Schedule to this notice.
3. A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 20 December 2021, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, including a plan specifying the road or lengths of road affected by the Order, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5DX.
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof, or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977(c) shall have effect as though:-
  - (a) for the item in Schedule 1 to that Order numbered 915 there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
