Bushey Road to be subject to 30mph speed limit between Grand Drive and Martin way

#### Reason for decision

The dual carriageway section of Bushey Road provides a transition from the A3 entering Merton; from 40 to 30 to 20mph. Feedback from residents on the doorstep during the 2022 local elections called for part of the road to return to 30mph. this section of dual carriageway has a 'movement function' and no homes or shops are directly accessed from this stretch of the road. Like Croydon Road in Mitcham, as an entry point to the borough which is also 30mph, I believe that due to the characteristics and function of Bushey Road, the speed limit should revert to 30mph between Grand Drive and Martin way.

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To retain the existing 20mph speed limit. Rejected because of the above reason for decision.
