Decision

I agree to the undertaking of the statutory consultation to change the existing 20mph speed limit along Bushey Rd between Grand Drive and Martin Way to 30mph and in the absence of any objections for officers to progress with its implementation.

Reason for decision

There are no properties fronting this section of Bushey Road and it has the same characteristics as the other section of Bushey Road that is subject to the 30mph speed limit. Therefore, it is proposed that between Grand Drive and Martin Way, the speed limit be changed from 20mph to 30mph to be in keeping with the rest of Bushey Road. Bushey Road would then be subject to 30mph speed limit for its entirety between the A3 and Martin Way.

Alternative options considered and why rejected

To retain the existing 20mph speed limit. Rejected because of the above reason for decision.
