PROPOSED PARKING PLACES FOR THE LAMP POST CHARGING OF ELECTRIC VEHICLES

- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Merton propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the 'Electric Vehicle Charging Points' Order would be to: -
 - (a) designate parking places for electric vehicle charging at the locations listed in the Schedules to this notice;
 - (b) provide that the parking places would operate at all times, unless otherwise stated;
 - (c) specify that the parking places in controlled parking zones referred to in the Schedule to this notice would be available for fully electric and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles only, for up to 12 hours, provided that during controlled parking zone operational hours the applicable charge for the relevant controlled parking zone permit has been paid with respect to the vehicle and that any electric vehicle is connected via a charging lead to a lamp column upgraded to enable electric charging at all times while it is left in a parking place. Electric vehicles having left a parking place for electric vehicle charging would be able to return after 4 hours have elapsed.
- 3. The general effect of the 'Parking Places Amendment' Orders would be to remove an existing length of parking place in the lengths of road listed in the Schedule to this notice to accommodate the introduction of a parking place designated for electric vehicle charging.
- 4. A copy of the proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including plans which indicate the lengths of road to which the Orders relate can be inspected Monday to Friday during normal office hours at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden. SCHEDULE

Proposed Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Places in Controlled Parking Zones – CPZ Permit Required

<u>CPZ RP</u>

RICHMOND ROAD, SW20; the south-west side, from a point 15.5 metres north-west of the northwestern kerb-line of Avenue Road north-westward for a distance of 6 metres.

RICHMOND ROAD, SW20; the south-west side, from a point 3.3 metres south-east of the common boundary of Richmond Court and Amber Court, north-westward for a distance of 5.5 metres.

CPZ RPC

AMITY GROVE, SW20; the north side, from a point 11 meres east of the eastern kerb-line of Durham Road, eastward for a distance of 5.5 metres.

DURHAM ROAD, SW20; the east side, from the common boundary of Nos. 122 and 124A Durham Road southward for a distance of 6 metres.

DURHAM ROAD, SW20; the east side, from the common boundary of Nos. 142 and 146 Durham Road northward for a distance of 6 metres.

<u>CPZ W7</u>

ALBERT GROVE, SW20; the north-east side, from a point 5.5 metres north-west the common boundary of No. 3 Albert Grove and No. 138 Worple Road north-westward for a distance of 5.2 metres.

DELAMERE ROAD, SW20; the north-east side, from a point 12.4 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Worple Road south-eastward for a distance of 5.5 metres.

ETHELBERT ROAD, SW20; the north-west side, from a point 9.6 metres south-west of the north-east boundary of No. 9 Delamere Road south-westward for a distance of 6 metres.

SOUTHDOWN ROAD, SW20; the north-west side, from a point 6 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Lower Downs Road north-eastward for a distance of 5.5 metres.

THE DOWNS, SW20; the south-west side, from a point 14.6 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Worple Road north-westward for a distance of 5.3 metres.
