Proposed Parking Amendments W4 CPZ – Graham Road

The purpose of this leaflet is to advise you that following a petition from some Graham Road residents requesting changes to the current parking bays in Graham Road to address parking difficulties, the Council is proposing to convert the existing pay and display shared use bays in Graham Road to Permit Holder Only bays. The existing hours of operation will remain unchanged in that these bays will operate Monday to Saturday between 8.30am and 11pm and Sunday between 2 and 6pm.

The proposed changes are shown on the enclosed drawing (Z78-374-01).

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

A Notice of the Council's intention to introduce the above measures will be published in a local newspaper and the London Gazette; Notices will also be posted on lamp columns in the vicinity. Representations against the proposals described in this Notice must be made in writing or email trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk by no later than **15 July 2022** quoting reference **ES/GrahamRd**. Objections must relate only to the elements of the scheme that are subject to this statutory consultation.

All representations along with Officers' comments and recommendations will be presented in a report to the Cabinet Member for Transport. Please note that responses to any representations received will not be made until a final decision is made by the Cabinet Member.

The Council is required to give weight to the nature and content of your representation and not necessarily the quantity. Your reasons are, therefore, important to us.
