The Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 512) Order 2022

Made: 22 November 2022

Coming into force: 28 November 2022

The Council of the London Borough of Merton, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 28 November 2022 may be cited as the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 512) Order 2022.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the provisions of the Schedules to the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (CPZ W3) Order 2004(c) and the provisions of the Schedules to the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 307) Order 2011(d) are hereby revoked in so far as those provisions relate to any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977(e) shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) there were added to Schedule 1 to that Order the item numbered 3294 and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - (b) there were added to Schedule 2 to that Order the item numbered 629 and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
