The Merton (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) (Lucien Road) Experimental Traffic Order

Made: 8 February 2023

Coming into force: 20 February 2023

The London Borough of Merton, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all others powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on 20 February 2023 and may be cited as the Merton (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) (Lucien Road) Experimental Traffic Order 2023.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the item numbered 3 and set out in columns, 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order shall be added to the Schedule of the Merton (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) (Wimbledon Park Primary School) (No. 2) Traffic Order 2022(c).
3. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Head of futureMerton for the time being in the London Borough of Merton, or some person authorised in that behalf by him, may, if appears to him or that person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend this Order or any provision thereof.
