## PROPOSED WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND REVOCATION OF 20 MINUTE MAXIMUM STAY PARKING BAYS, WIMBLEDON BRIDGE

## THE MERTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. \*) ORDER 202\* THE MERTON (PARKING PLACES) (REVOCATION) (NO. \*) ORDER 202\*

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be to: -
  - (a) remove the 20 minutes maximum stay parking bays located in the street or length of street specified in the Schedule to this notice;
  - (b) prohibit waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) 'at any time' in the street or length of street specified in the Schedule to this notice;
  - (c) prohibit waiting by vehicles for the purposes of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 40 minutes in the same place between 7am and 10am and between 4pm and 7pm Mondays to Saturdays in the street or length of street specified in the Schedule to this notice.
  - N.B. The picking up and dropping off of passengers would be permitted.
- 3.
