This leaflet is to update you on the outcome of the statutory consultation that was carried out between 9<sup>th</sup> October and 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2023 on the proposals to introduce 'At any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) in Woodlands.

The statutory consultation resulted in 20 representations from Woodlands, many of which are partially in favour of the restrictions with a request to place the proposed yellow lines on the other side of the road. The representations along with officer's recommendations were reported to the Cabinet Member for Transport on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023. After careful consideration, in line with the requests received, it has been agreed to carry out a further statutory consultation in Woodlands to introduce waiting restrictions on the other side of the road.
