I hereby state my objection to the proposed removal of the clause which states that no building taller than 19 storeys shall be built in Colliers Wood.

Britannia Point is already far above any local structure and can be seen from as far as Streatham and Sutton.

Therefore, not only will any new tower further detract from the prevailing setting, but have a huge physical impact on residents. The shadows such a structure would cast would rob homes of sunlight and further worsen the already wind impacts felt around the tower by pedestrians and cyclists.

Merton has a track record of meeting or exceeding its housing targets in recent years and there are hundreds of sites across the borough that could contribute to this target. It should not be on Colliers Wood to bear the brunt for meeting these targets, rather than carrying out a balanced and reasoned development plan across the borough.
