Proposed Parking Amendments W4 CPZ – Graham Road

Dear Resident / Business,

The purpose of this leaflet is to advise you of the outcome of the consultation that was carried out on proposal to convert existing pay and display shared use to permit holder only bays. The statutory consultation resulted in 7 representations in support of the proposed change with all 7 representations requesting Sunday restrictions to be extended to operate 8.30am to 11pm.

Since the statutory consultation was only based on changing the parking bays and the introduction of the waiting restrictions, at this stage the Cabinet Member has approved the shared use bays conversion to permit holders only bays operating Monday – Saturday between 8.30am-11pm and Sunday between 2 and 6pm; it has also been agreed to implement the proposed waiting restrictions. Although the petition from Graham Road requested for the hours of operation on Sunday to be extended, this was not consulted upon. With regards to any change to the operational periods, it is not possible to treat Graham Road in isolation. Graham Road is part of an area wide zone - W4 CPZ and to change the hours of operation of the zone, a zone wide petition would be required. Once a zone wide petition is received, the Council will programme a zone wide informal consultation to determine level of support within the zone.

DATE AND TIME OF WORKS

The works on changing of the signs are programmed to start 21 September 2022 for a period of 1 day, weather permitting. The road marking for the permit holder only bays was completed as part of the resurfacing works.

The Council is conscious of the inconvenience and the disruption these works may cause and will endeavour to keep the impact to a minimum. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience.
