### **Proposed waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) Church Path – statutory consultation**

The Council has received complaints from the community including refuse collectors and the Council Green Space Team regarding obstructive and dangerous parking in Church Path at the cul de sac end. In response to these complaints the Council is proposing to introduce waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) to address obstructive parking and assist with movement of traffic.

Please see the attached plan, overleaf, to illustrate the proposed extents of the double yellow lines.

### **WHAT HAPPENS NEXT**

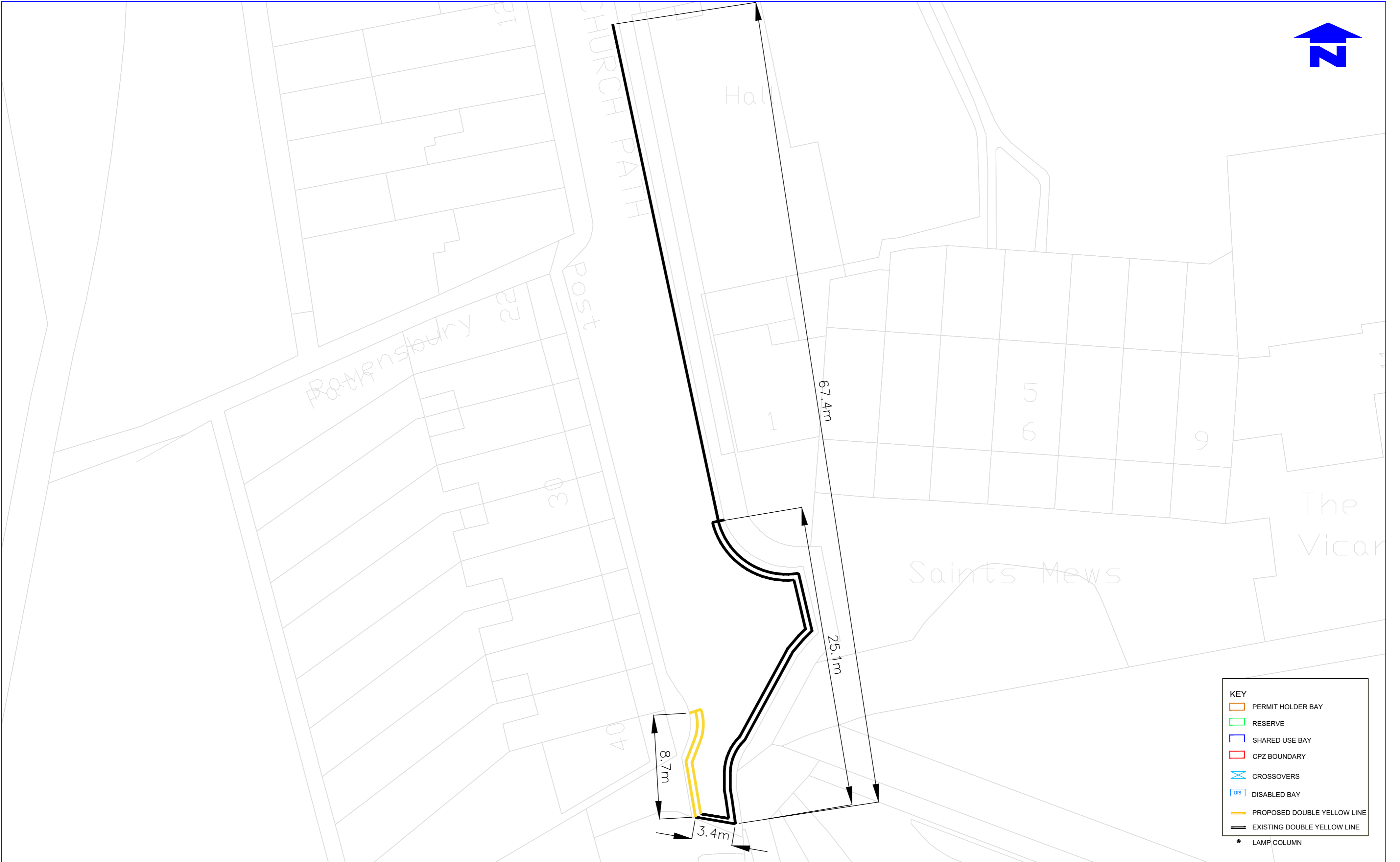
A Notice of the Council's intention to introduce the above measures will be published in a local newspaper (Wimbledon and Wandsworth Times), London Gazette and posted on lamp columns in the vicinity. Representations against the proposals described in this Notice must be made no later than **10 February 2023** quoting reference **ES/WR2022B2**.
