3. Clear signs that are a minimum A4 size are placed at exit points stating "This is a residential area please leave quietly".
4. Patrons shall not use the external drinking area after 23.00 hours.
5. The use shall only operate between the hours of 8.00am and 12 o'clock midnight Mondays to Saturdays and 8.00am to 11.30pm, Sundays with no meal sittings commencing after 11pm Mondays to Saturdays and 10.30pm Sundays. No other operational times shall be permitted without prior written consent from the Local Planning Authority.
6. Deliveries to the property shall only be permitted between the hours of 08.00 and 18.00 hours Monday to Friday and 08.00 and 13.00 hours on Saturdays and not on any Sundays, Bank Holidays, Christmas Day or Good Friday without the prior consent in writing of the Local Planning Authority.
7. No amplified including live music, with the exception of background pipe music shall be permitted within the dining/restaurant area; no live music in the bar area and no music at any time in the garden/car parking areas, without prior consent in writing of the Local Planning Authority.
8. No play equipment or seating or dining facilities shall be permitted within the garden areas/patio area, without the prior consent in writing of the Local Planning Authority.
9. The total number of seats/covers permitted in the ground floor restaurant/bar and holding area shall not exceed 180 seats, unless prior approval has been obtained in writing from the Local planning Authority.
10. The only customer access point to and from the building shall be via the front or side entrances (provided that this condition shall not apply to disabled persons or in case of an emergency).
