Services for families with children from pregnancy to age 5 who are registered with Merton's children's centres

Support sessions and groups

Family Information and Support Hubs (FISH)

Get help and support from a specialist advisor for any concerns you may have about housing, finances, relationships, your child's development or behaviour, access to training or employment and more. Our staff will offer support and guidance, helping you to access relevant information and services.

Portage Support Group (2-3 years)

You and your child can develop targets and skills alongside other children with significant additional needs and their families, learn to socialise in a small group and help get your child ready for going to nursery.

Social Communication Group (2 years 2 months to start of Reception year at school)

For parents of children with communication and language delay. This group helps you support your child to develop their listening, attention, understanding and speaking skills and help their communication at home.

Programmes that can be booked directly

Early Learning Together (ELT) Baby Programme (0-7 months)

For all first-time parents and their babies, this programme helps you understand your baby's early brain development and teaches you massage strokes you can use to soothe and comfort your baby. The programme is running in children's centres and online (virtually). You will need access to a computer/tablet/laptop/phone to take part in the online programme. If you think any of the four courses below will be of benefit to you and your family please speak to a children's centre worker, your health worker or lead practitioner.

Early Learning Together (ELT) Toddler Programme (8-18 months and 19-36 months)

This programme supports you to understand your child's development. It gives you ideas for activities and games to enjoy with your child that supports their healthy development.

Early Learning Together (ELT) Preschool Programme

This programme is for children who are eligible for free early education for 2, 3 or 4-year-olds and their parents. Your child will find out what it's like to go to nursery or preschool, helping you and them to manage separation.

Incredible Years Baby Programme

This programme is for parents and carers and their babies. It gives you information about how babies grow and develop and how you can support your baby in the early months of their life, including communicating with them, safety and where to get advice and support.

ESOL Stepping Stones English

This programme is for Merton parents and carers with a baby aged under 1 year who are looking to start learning English language skills.

Referral programmes for parents

Incredible Years (IY) Autism and Language Delay Programme (2 years to end of Reception year)

For parents of children on the autistic spectrum (or currently being diagnosed) or with language delay. Helping you to support your child's emotional regulation, social and language skills, school readiness and relationships.

Incredible Years Toddler Programme and Nursery and Reception Programmes (1 yr to end of Reception)

The Incredible Years Toddler Programme and Nursery and Reception Programmes provides support for parents and carers to understand your child's development and how you can best support them.

Triple P: 0-12 (3-12 years)

This course is for parents and carers who have concerns about their child's behaviour or wish to prevent behavioural problems from developing.

A range of support programmes for parents of children aged 0 to 16 are available. If you think you may need support with parenting or you would benefit from any of the programmes above, please speak to a member of children's centre staff, your health visitor, school or any other professional working with you and your child.
