The Merton (Prescribed Route) (Botsford Road) Traffic Order 2021

Made: 15 November 2021

Coming into force: 29 November 2021

The London Borough of Merton, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on 29 November 2021 and may be cited as the Merton (Prescribed Route) (Botsford Road) Experimental Traffic Order 2020.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Botsford Road, SW20 to turn right into Whatley Avenue.
3. Nothing in Article 3 of this the Order shall apply to:-
 - (a) to any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer in uniform;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

4. The Merton (Prescribed Route) (Botsford Road) Experimental Traffic Order 2020(c) is hereby revoked.
