

Dear Occupier,

As you are aware, during September 2020 the Council banned the right motorised vehicular movement from Botsford Rd into Whatley Avenue under an Experimental Order. The 6-months statutory consultation closed in March 2021.

All feedback received have now been considered and a final decision has been made to make the scheme permanent. This means that the permanent Traffic Management Order will be made shortly. In terms of physical measures directly associated with the banned movement, no change will be made.

Please note that all Emergency Services and cyclists are exempt.
