Dear Resident / Business

Following the Council's decision to introduce parking measures in Church Road, Lancaster Road, High Street & Courthope Road. I am writing to inform you that the lining and signing works will start shortly, which will be carried out by F M Conway Ltd on behalf of the Council.

Date and Time of Works

It is anticipated that the lining works will start the week commencing 25 February 2013 for a period of 1 week, weather permitting. Work will be carried out between 9am and 4.30pm. To allow the works to be carried out as quickly as possible, temporary parking restrictions may be introduced. "No Parking" cones and signs will be in place to indicate the areas where parking would be prohibited. While work is being undertaken in your street, we request that you park considerately within the existing bays which will allow the lining contractors to refresh existing markings if required. By doing so, this will allow a smooth transition of the works. Notices and cones will be placed in your road 12 – 48hrs prior to work being undertaken.

The information pack on how to apply for your permit will follow shortly. The Council is conscious of the inconvenience and the disruption that this work may cause and will endeavour to keep the impact to a minimum. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused by these works.

Dear Resident/Business,

The purpose of this leaflet is to let you know the outcome of the statutory consultation carried out in October 2012, and to inform you of the Council's decision on the proposed measures as shown on the enclosed plan.

The representations received along with officers' recommendations were reported to the Cabinet Member for Environmental Sustainability and Regeneration on 21 December 2012. After Careful consideration a decision has been made to proceed with the making of the Traffic Management Order (TMO):

- To allow parking on Saturdays between 8.30am and 6.30pm within the Pay and Displays bays in Church Road and High Street.
- To convert the loading bay in Courthope Road to shared use bays thereby allowing parking between 8 and 10am, 20 minutes free no return within two hours and loading will be permitted between 10am and 6.30pm.
- To convert the first set of shared use bays on the south side of Lancaster Road close to its junction with Church Road to pay and display only bays.
- To convert some Resident only bays to shared use and introduce pay and display shared use bays on the west side of Lancaster Road between its junction with Lancaster Gardens and 23/25 Lancaster Road.
- Agrees to review the scheme between 6 12 months after implementation subject to available funding.
- To re-introduce 20 minutes free parking at certain Pay and Display (P&D) bays in the Village and Arthur Road.
- Agrees to introduce additional Resident Only parking bays on existing single yellow line out side properties Nos. 7/9 Lancaster Road.

The final made Traffic Management Orders (TMOs), which allows the restrictions to be implemented and administered, will be published in the London Gazette
