Dear Resident

I am writing to inform you of the Council's intention to carry out a consultation with residents in the Graveney ward, on proposals to introduce parking controls. This is in response to petitions received from some residents in Ascot Road, Boscombe Road and Cromer Road (ABC Roads).

The roads being consulted are:- Ascot Road, Boscombe Road, Cromer Road, Bruce Road, Glenfell Road Sirdar Road, Inglemere Road and parts of Links Road, Seely Road and Gorrington Park Avenue (see plan of CPZ proposal overleaf)

Following a residents' meeting in February 2009, it was agreed with ward Councillors that the Council would write to the residents living outside the area where the parking controls are being proposed (area within the green boundary shown on the plan overleaf) to advise of the Council's intention.

I am therefore writing to seek your views to introduce parking controls in the roads listed above and to request that you take time to answer the enclosed questionnaire. Before answering the questionnaire, please consider the impact that parking displacement may have in your road if controlled parking zone was introduced in the area bounded by the red line shown on the plan overleaf).

Should the majority of residents consulted confirmed the need for parking controls in your area, the Council will then develop a scheme for further consultation with residents.

Therefore the Council would like to know if you wish to be consulted on a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ). Please be sure to complete the enclosed pre-paid questionnaire and return it by 30 October 2009, together with any further comments you may have.

Please see back of this letter for details of forthcoming of a residents' meeting to discuss the proposals.
