### Dear Resident/Business

The purpose of this leaflet is to inform you of the outcome of the consultation carried during November/December 2010 and to provide a further opportunity for residents of All Saints Road, Deburgh Road, Hanover Road, Haydon's Road (northern section) and Norman Road (northern section) to air their views on proposals to be included within the S3 CPZ. Results of this consultation showed a number representations received within the proposed extension area who would like to be included in the controlled zone, due to the current parking problems being experienced and the inevitable displacement that will occur creating further difficulties.

All representations of the consultation along with officers' recommendations were presented in a report to the Street Management Advisory Committee and the Cabinet Member on 10 February 2011. After careful consideration, a decision was made to:

- Proceed with a statutory consultation on proposals to include All Saints Road, Deburgh Road, Hanover Road, Haydon's Road and Norman Road (North sections) into the 'S3' CPZ
- Proceed with the making of the Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) for the implementation of the proposed 'S3' CPZ to include Autumn Close, Burns Close, Chaucer Way, Downside Close, Gilbert Road, Grove Road, Hailes Close, the southern part of Haydon's Road, Holmes Road, Hotham Road, Keats Close, Kipling Drive, Laburnum Road, Lacock Close, Leyton Road, the southern part of Norman Road, North Road, Pope Close and Shelley Way operational Mondays to Fridays between 8.30am to 6.30pm
- Proceed with the making of the Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) for the implementation of the proposed double yellow line waiting restrictions at key locations such as junctions, bends, cul de sacs and locations where traffic flow is impeded to include Abingdon Road, All Saints Road, Battle Close, Bewley Street, Deburgh Road, East Road, Hanover Road, Merton High Street, Norman Road, South Road, Tintern Close and Woburn Close

### WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

A statutory consultation is required prior to any decision to proceed to implement. This is the legal part of the process and requires the introduction of Traffic Management Order (TMO), which will enable the Council to change and enforce traffic or parking regulations. The statutory Notice will be published in the London Gazette and one local newspaper circulated in the area. In addition to this, the Council will post Notices in the affected streets and deliver newsletters to local residents and traders. The Notice informs residents and businesses in the affected area of the proposed measures and how members of the public can submit written representations regarding the proposals.

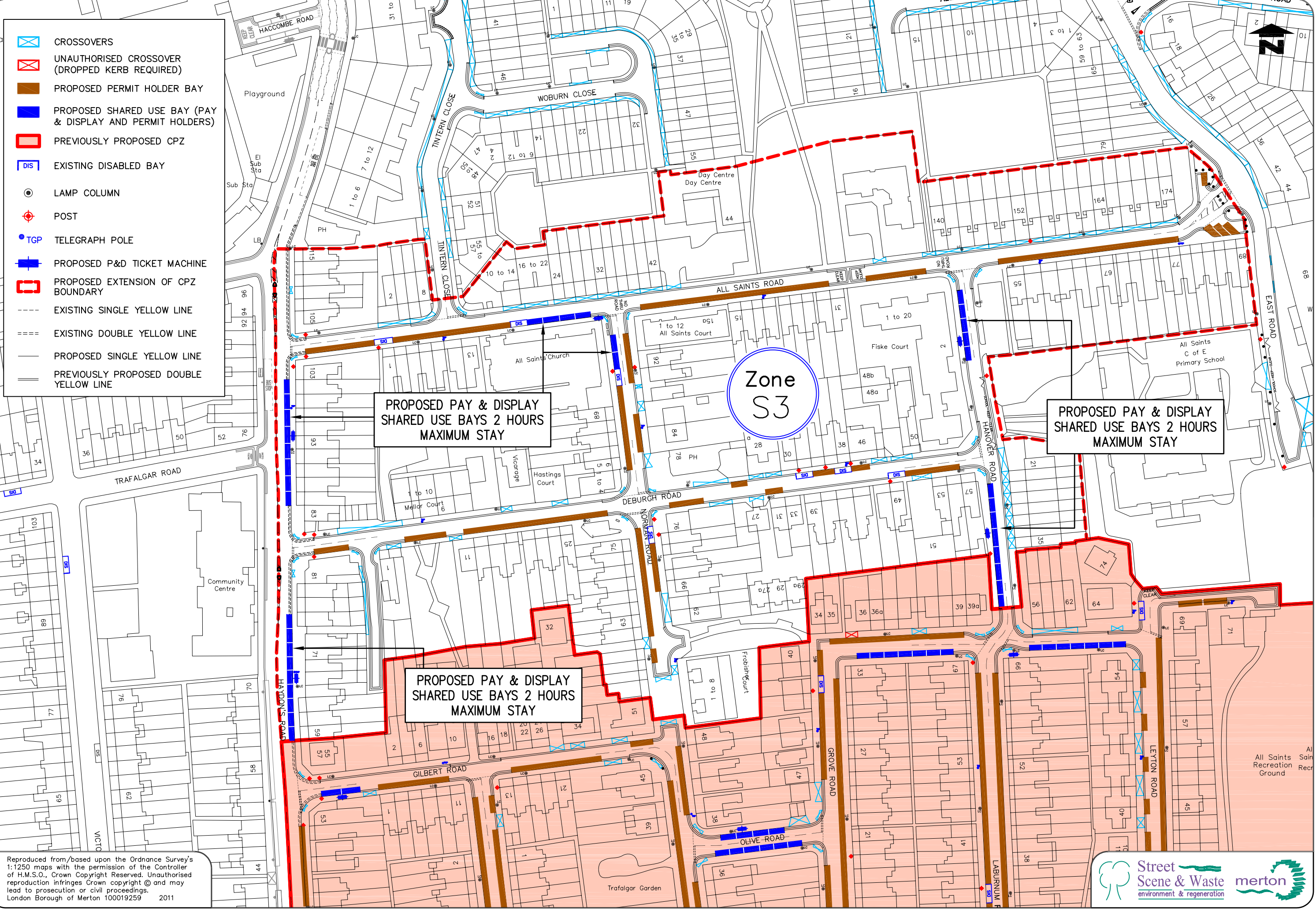
