Dear Resident/Business

The purpose of this leaflet is to advise you that following representations made to the Council by some local businesses regarding insufficient short term parking provision for their patrons, the Council is proposing to make some changes to the Pay and Display (P&D) bays in The Rush and Kingston Road. This particular proposal is to assist the businesses in the vicinity with their parking needs.

## PROPOSED CHANGES

The proposed change is to allow 20 minutes free parking in the P&D and shared-use bays as in the other part of the Borough. The P&D machine will issue a ticket which will allow free parking for the first 20 minutes by pressing the green button. Please note that it is an offence to obtain any additional 20 minutes free parking thereafter.

## WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

A Notice of the Council's intention to introduce the above measure will be published in a local newspaper (The Guardian), London Gazette and posted on lamp columns in the vicinity. Representations against the proposals described in this Notice must be made in writing to the **Head of Traffic and Highways, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5DX** or email [trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk](mailto:trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk) by no later than **4 September 2014** quoting reference **P012 - 14**. Objections must relate only to the elements of the scheme that are subject to this statutory consultation.

All representations along with Officers' comments and recommendations will be presented in a report to the Cabinet Member for Environmental Sustainability and Regeneration. Please note that responses to any representations received will not be made until a final decision is made by the Cabinet Member.

The Council is required to give weight to the nature and content of your representation and not necessarily the quantity. Your reasons are, therefore, important to us. Copies of the proposed Traffic Management Order (TMO) may be viewed at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5DX during the Council's normal office hours Monday to Friday 9am - 5pm.

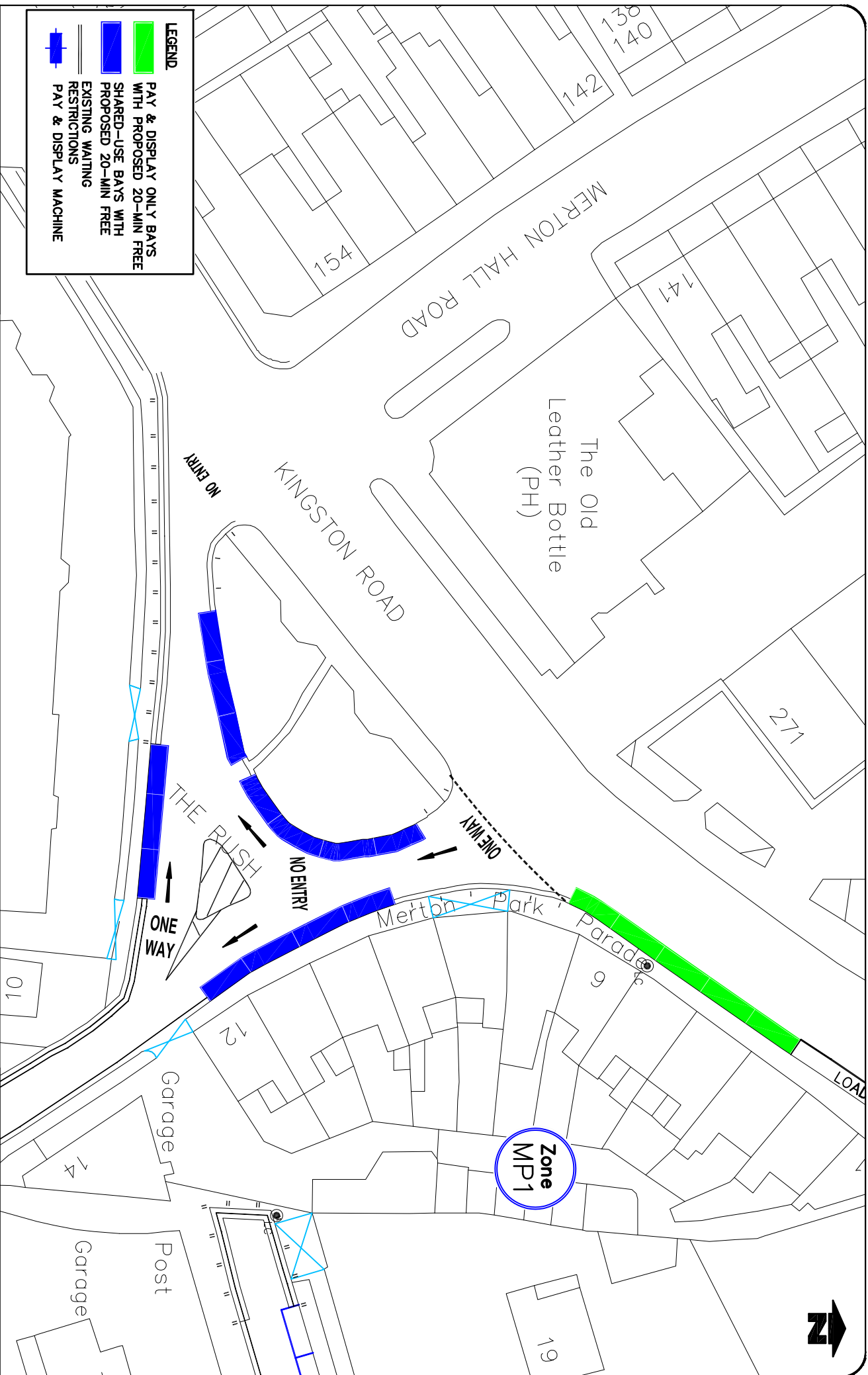
