# ENFORCEMENT NOTICE - OPERATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

# ISSUED BY THE LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON

1. **THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE** issued by the Council because it appears that there has been a breach of planning control under Section 171A(1)(a) of the above Act, at the land described below. The Council considers it expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material considerations.

#### 2. THE LAND AFFECTED

Land at 39 West Barnes Lane Raynes Park London SW20 0BL in the London Borough of Merton shown edged red on the attached plan ('the Land').

#### 3. THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL ALLEGED

Without planning permission, the erection on the Land of a metal shed type structure, capable of accommodating two vehicles for painting and drying, and the installation along the North boundary of the Land of a large and unsightly metal panel fence and the placing of floodlights atop existing fence posts.

## 4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- (a) It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last four years.
- (b) The material development is contrary to the requirements of policies CS.14 (Design) of the Merton Local Plan (2011) and PE.2 (Pollution and Amenity) and BE.23 (Alterations and Extensions) of the Adopted Merton Unitary Development Plan (2003), by reason of light pollution from the floodlights and because the large metal shed does not use external materials/design that are/is sympathetic to the location and its surroundings or complement the character and appearance of the wider setting.

#### 5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- (a) Remove all unauthorised structures from the Land, including the large metal shed and the fencing with floodlights to the North of the Land.
- (b) Lawfully dispose of all waste materials resulting from compliance with (a) above.

Time for Compliance: within one month from the date this notice takes effect.

## 6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 14 January unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

# YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

You can appeal against this notice in writing to the Secretary of State, but any appeal must be received, or posted in time to be received, by the Planning Inspectorate before the notice takes effect. The enclosed Explanatory Note and Information Sheet set out the procedure to be followed if you wish to appeal.

# FEE PAYABLE FOR THE DEEMED APPLICATION

If your ground of appeal is, or includes ground (a) that planning permission should be granted, you must include with your appeal a fee, which is double that payable for a normal planning application. The total fee payable is £770.00 that must be paid by way of a cheque made out to the London Borough of Merton. The fee can be sent with your appeal form.


# WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL
