5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

(a) remove the single storey rear extension and all resulting debris and materials from the land.

Time for Compliance: 3 months from the date this notice takes effect.

This notice takes effect on 18 October 2004 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.
