1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control under Section 171A(1)(a) of the Act at the land (hereinafter referred to as "the land") described in Paragraph 2 below. The Council considers that it is expedient to issue this Notice having regard to the provisions of the Development Plan and to other material planning considerations.

2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

The land known as 21 Melrose Avenue, Mitcham, and shown edged black on the attached plan.

3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the erection of a single storey rear extension.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred in the last four years.

Retrospective planning permission was refused for the retention of this extension because it is considered that by virtue of its size and proximity to the adjacent property it is an unneighbourly form of development resulting in a loss of outlook and overshadowing, detrimental to the residential amenities of 19 Melrose Avenue.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- (a) Remove the single storey rear extension, lying adjacent to the boundary with 19 Melrose Avenue and the subject of planning application reference 02/P0607;
- (b) Remove from the site all materials and debris resulting from the demolition of the extension.

Time for compliance: 90 days after the Notice takes effect.

6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This Notice takes effect on the 22^{nd} October 2002 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.
