NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton, after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis under powers conferred by Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intend to relocate the existing control area of the crossing on Kingston Road located in the vicinity of Rothesay Avenue, so that it extends on the north-western side, from the south-western kerb-line of Rothesay Avenue to the boundary wall of property Nos 363 and 365 Kingston Road and on the south-east side from a point 16.4 metres south-west of the north-eastern boundary wall of property No.288 Kingston Road, to a point 1.5 metres south-west of the boundary wall of property Nos 304 and 306 Kingston Road.
- 2. A plan of the area showing the crossing can be inspected during normal office hours on Monday to Friday at the Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey.
