The Council of the London Borough Of Merton, having consulted with the Commissioner for the Metropolitan Police, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b), and all other powers, so enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

 - (b) there were added to Schedule 2 to that Order the items numbered * to * and set in columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule 2 to this Order.
