## Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ)

P1 review- Ryfold Road

### Dear Resident/Business

The purpose of this leaflet is to update you of the outcome of the informal consultation carried out between 21 January and 8 February 2019 on the proposed extension of the existing P1 CPZ operational hours and a general zone review.

### P1 CPZ REVIEW CONSULTATION RESULTS

The consultation resulted in a total of 184 online responses. After removing duplicate/multiple returns and those who do not live within the existing P1 CPZ, the overall response rate was 31%. Of the 184 who responded 103 (53%) did not support a change in days, while 70 (39%) supported Monday to Sunday and 11 (6%) supported Monday to Saturday.

Further analysis of the results on a road-by-road basis indicated that there is some support for change, mainly from those streets where the petition originated, namely Crescent Gardens, The Crescent and Farquhar Road. However, given the geographical position of these roads within the CPZ, it is not possible to apply the extended hours of operation in these roads alone nor would it be possible to change the zone boundary to include these roads.

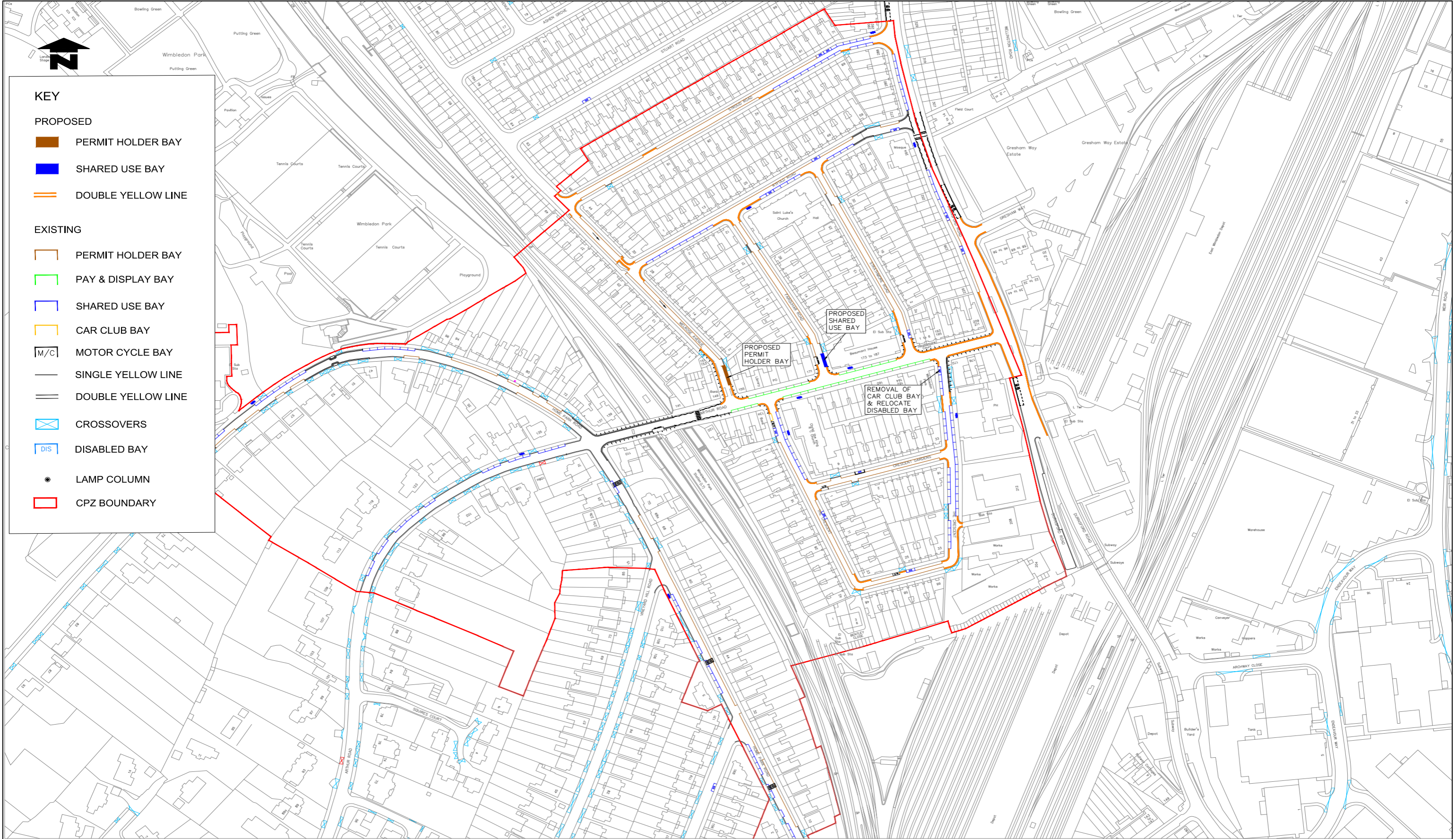
The results of the consultation along with officers' recommendations were presented in a report to the Cabinet Member for Regeneration, Housing and Transport on the 24 April 2019. The following recommendations which were made to the Cabinet Member have now been agreed:

- Not to proceed with any amendment to the existing CPZ operational hours.
- To proceed with statutory consultation to introduce permit parking bay in Melrose Avenue outside 2a and pay and display share use bays in Farquhar Road near its junction with Arthur Road.
- To proceed with the statutory consultation of the relevant Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) and the implementation of the 'At any time' waiting restrictions at all junctions within P1 CPZ.

### WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

A Notice of the Council's intention to introduce the above measures will be published in a local newspaper (The Guardian), London Gazette and posted on lamp columns in the vicinity. Representations against the proposals described in this Notice must be made in writing or email to [trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk](mailto:trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk) by no later than **14 February 2020** quoting reference ES/P1 REVIEW. Objections must relate only to the elements of the scheme that are subject to this statutory consultation.

A copy of the proposed Traffic Management Orders (TMOs), a plan identifying the areas affected by the proposals and the Council's Statement of Reasons can be inspected at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5DX during the Council's normal office hours Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm or at West Barnes Library.
