Demolition of existing buildings and erection of a nine storey building with additional basement level, comprising 6,713 sq.m. of offices, with flexible retail and cafe/restaurant at ground and first floor levels and associated works. The Panel reviewed a previous proposal for a hotel on this site in Jan 2016 (16/P0025/NEW), giving it Amber verdict. Since then another application has also been approved for an office development on the site.
