The Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 494) Order 2021

Made: 15 September 2021

Coming into force: 20 September 2021

The London Borough of Merton, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all others powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into force on 20 September 2021 and may be cited as the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 494) Order 2021.
- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977(c) shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) there were substituted for the item numbered 702 in Schedule 1 to that Order the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

4. The Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Sandy Lane) Experimental Traffic Order 2020(d) is hereby revoked.
